

Creative Decisions Foundation Support for Students Presenting at MCDM2022

Students may apply to Creative Decisions Foundation (CDF) to receive reimbursement for their registration fee for the MCDM2022 conference. To qualify for this support the applicant must be a currently enrolled graduate or undergraduate student and satisfy the following:

1. Have submitted an abstract and had it accepted to present at the MCDM2022 conference.
2. Prepare a manuscript of 6 – 10 pages for a publishable paper extended from their accepted abstract. Please follow the IJAHP guidelines available at:

3. Include a brief vita detailing education, professional accomplishments to date and level of familiarity with AHP, ANP.
4. Email the manuscript and vita to the head of Creative Decisions Foundation, Rozann Saaty (rozann@creativedecisions.net) by May 30, 2022. Students will be informed if their manuscript qualifies for support by June 6, 2022.

Given that this support is aimed at encouraging MCDM participation and helping students learn to prepare manuscripts for publication, it is expected that the student will personally present his/her work in the event. There will be CDF representatives attending the conference who will provide the reimbursement there in US Dollars. Students will be instructed who to approach and will need to show their MCDM receipt, current student ID, and sign a receipt to receive the cash.

Important: Students who do not personally present their work in the MCDM2022 conference, for whatever reason, will not be reimbursed their registration fee.
